



## Albemarle 410 XF

A 'FLARE' FOR STYLE, AN EYE FOR QUALITY

**WITH MORE THAN 130 BOAT BUILDERS** in North Carolina, it's easy to see how the distinctive flared bow of the Carolina sportfisher has become more common on the West Coast. But it isn't just sheer numbers that sends the boats on the cross-country trek; serious anglers love the tournament-quality features and get-there-yesterday speeds. Among the latest new models to arrive here is the Albemarle 410 XF — a solid example of the successful Carolina sportfishing tradition, and a blend of comfort and practicality.

The fishing equipment includes a 56-gallon transom fishbox, a 57-gallon insulated cockpit fishbox with a macerator and coldplate, a 20-gallon combination sink and livewell, a tackle and bait prep center, tackle storage, an icebox, two teak tuna chairs and four flush-mounted rod holders.

But of course, none of that equipment will do you any good unless you can get to the action quickly, and the 410 XF is definitely prepared to take a heavy beating. She is fitted with rugged 700 hp Caterpillar C12 engines, which propel her to a top speed of about 38 mph (typical cruising speed is 32 mph). She has three automatic bilge pumps, four-blade Nibrall propellers, Glendinning engine synchronizers, trolling valves for running at lower speeds and a Release Marine

Rybo-style steering wheel with side-mount level controls.

Albemarle takes a lot of pride in its hull design; the dramatic deadrise and telltale Carolina bow flare are designed specifically to do battle with head seas and to instill confidence in her passengers with her stability through any conditions. The company also runs the hulls through a battery of tests at the factory to ensure safety and quality.

The interior is just as impressive, with teak and holly flooring throughout, high-gloss cherry cabinetry, LCD TVs, climate control, a central vacuum system and a fully equipped galley. Though this boat is first and foremost a fishing machine, with a focus on outdoor amenities, she features a comfortable forward stateroom for

overnight accommodations, along with a single head. The long L-shaped settee in the salon converts to a double berth to accommodate guests. 🐾
